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OHSLA Spring 2012 Meeting Summary - submitted by Stevo Roksandic

The OHSLA Spring 2012 meeting was hosted by Mount Carmel Health Sciences Library (MCHSL) in Columbus, Ohio on Thursday, April 12, 2012. PJ Grier from the National Network of Libraries of Medicine, Southeastern/Atlantic Region and Jacqueline Leskovec, from the Greater Midwest Region, presented a 3 hour MLA CE course titled "Informatics for Librarians: Peeling the Onion." Thirty members attended this program which explored clinical informatics from several vantage points and illustrated the "front-facing" skills that librarians can bring to the field of clinical informatics and health care information technology. Following the course was a presentation by Becky Mehling from Ohio State University Hospital East. Becky shared her personal experience while working as an "IHIS Super User" on the implementation of the medical records at Ohio State University Medical Center during fall of 2011.

Evaluations indicated that the program was "Very Good" (41%) and "Excellent" (34%) and all program components including content, information, expertise of presenters, value of handouts and appropriateness of the format for topic received the highest score of "excellent". MCHSL as host of the event received excellent ratings for rooms, location and parking. Food was evaluated as very good. Suggestions were made to add an option on the registration form for attendees to indicate their dietary restrictions. This idea has been included in the Fall 2012 meeting registration form.

Seventy-three percent of the attendees reported full reimbursement from their institutions, while 20% reported no reimbursement. Most of the attendees were from Central (47%) and Northeast (30%) Ohio. Fifty-seven percent of attendees were from hospitals and 33% from academic libraries.

RAC Report - submitted by Mike McGraw, OHSLA Representative to GMR Regional Advisory Council

The next Greater Midwest Region RAC (Regional Advisory Council) meeting will be in Chicago on Thursday and Friday, November 15-16, 2012. My main activity this year has been to serve as Chair of the Planning & Evaluation working group, just one of several working groups or advisory committees formed in the most recent contract period. The Planning & Evaluation group, after exploring the feasibility of licensing the electronic resources necessary to publish a "toolkit" of instruments that would help those submitting proposal to the GMR with planning and evaluation, has decided that it is more within our capabilities to publish an annotated bibliography of such resources. We are working collaboratively on the content of that bibliography at this time and I hope to have a draft to present to the RAC in November.
