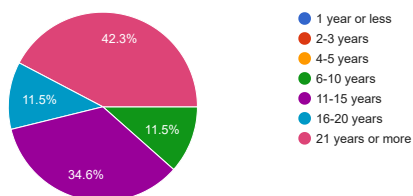


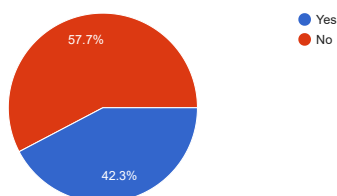

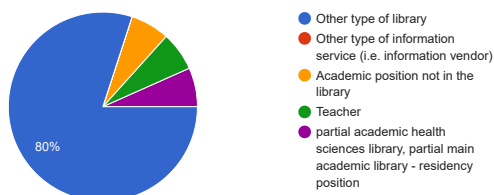
How many years have you been in the library/information field? 26 responses



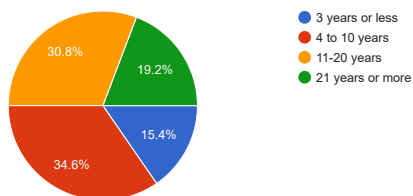
Was your FIRST professional position in a health sciences/medical library? 26 responses



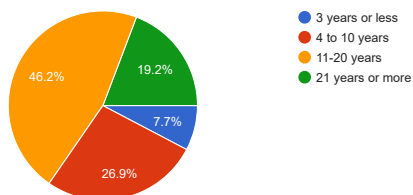
If no, where was your first professional position? 15 responses



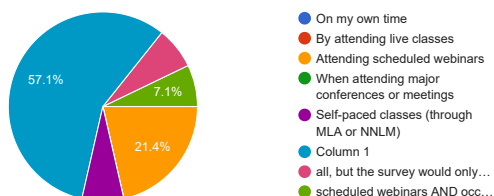

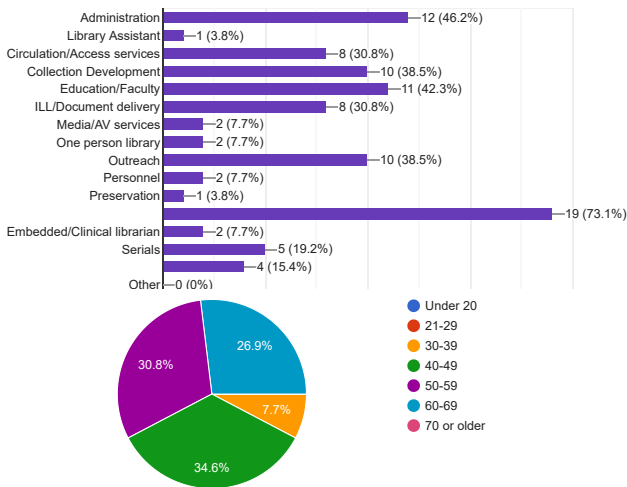

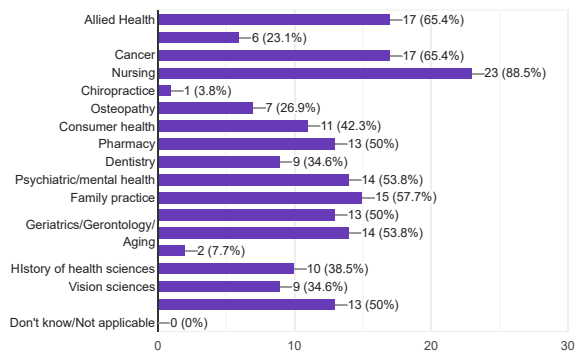

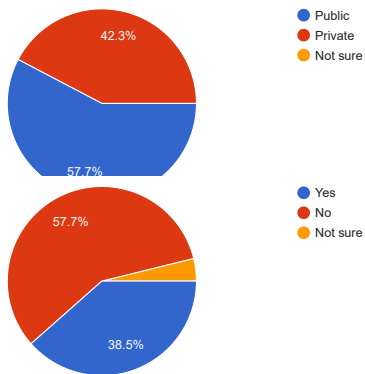

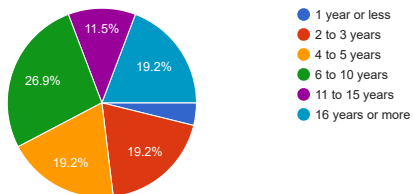

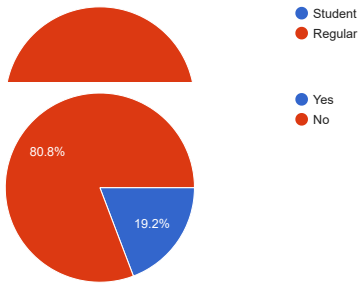

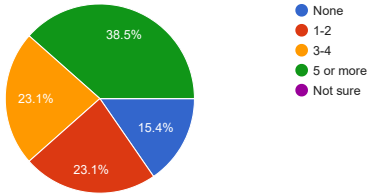

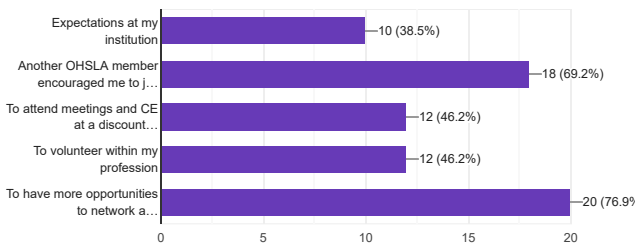

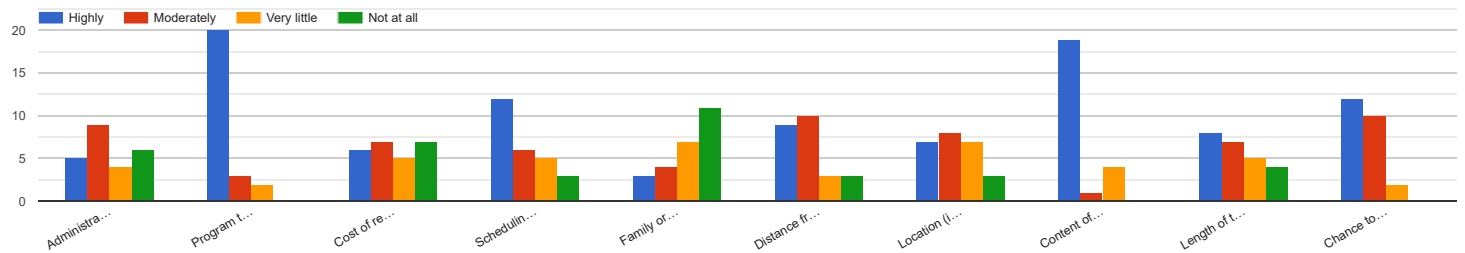

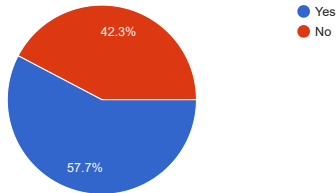

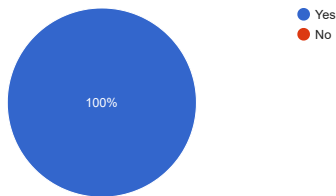

Coronavirus Information

We need much more frequent and robust communication. Putting all value into the annual or semi annual meetings is not enough to make me want to stay engaged.

Programming offered by OHSLA typically either isn't useful to me, or I obtained the information elsewhere. When I am interested, I usually do not attend due to conflicts with other meetings, a lack of funds, or a circumstance where there are too many meetings scheduled too close together. I think the COVID situation showed the potential of virtual meetings to overcome at least some of these issues (less travel, less cost).

Also, it might be helpful to consider scheduling meetings away from major conference times.

I wish that the degree question had offered check boxes instead of radio boxes. Both of my degrees are masters degrees so they are on the same level. I listed my MLS because that is required for my job but it was actually my first masters rather than my second. It would have been helpful to add a space for comments on many of the questions to allow clarification for various answers because there were a few choices where the available options did not fit my needs.

I love OHSLA and especially its members! Could we add shadowing opportunities for members to visit another member's library for a 1/2 day or so?
